

Make your own ...

Handprint Horses

"This could get messy! Wear old clothes and an apron!"

You will need:

- Paper or card
- Washable children's paint
- Felt-tip pen
- Glue
- Scraps of wool or fabric
- Lolly sticks



Pour some paint in a shallow tray and press both hands into the paint so your palms and fingers get nice and covered!



With your fingers spread wide, press them firmly in the middle of your paper to make two handprints.



Turn the paper round so your horses are the right way up! Now you're ready to give them a mane, tail and face!



Once the paint's dry, give your horses a mane and tail by glueing on scraps of wool or fabric, and draw them a face using felt-tip pen.



Make a paddock fence by glueing two rows of lolly sticks across, and then using more sticks as fence posts. Once your handprint horses have dried, they're ready to display for all to see! Don't forget to send a pic to mini@redwings.co.uk!
